1. Nationals Contest Site Entry

1.1 The U.S. National Aerobatic Championships is being held on the EAA AirVenture grounds and various EAA-owned buildings and facilities will be in use. Please note the changes in this Bulletin with regards to access to the Nationals site. The grounds are fenced and gated and there will be EAA Security in place at Gate 31 which will be the primary entrance to the grounds. Access through Gate 31 will only be possible with proper credentials as the event is not open to the public. The following is information as to how to gain access and obtain your credentials.

1.2 Flying in to Oshkosh

1.2.1 No change from Bulletin #2. Wristbands and parking passes will be available at Nationals Registration which will be located at EAA's Press Headquarters building.

1.3 Arrival by Car

- 1.3.1 Those who are arriving by car, to include judges, officials, volunteers, EAA and IAC members who come as observers, and coaches will have their credentials available if preregistered for the Nationals.
- 1.3.2 Welcome Packets for those arriving by car will be available at the EAA Aviation Museum. Please check with Reception. Packets will have your name along with the appropriate number of wristbands, a parking pass, and other information.
- 1.3.3 Arrivals by car can then proceed southbound from the Museum along Poberezny Road and then turn left (eastbound) on **Schaick Avenue**. This will take you to the West Gate and Forest Home Avenue. Proceed northbound on Forest Home Avenue to **L Lot** and **Gate 31.** See page 5 for a map of the AirVenture grounds. "CC" is also known as the West Gate and where you turn onto Schaick Avenue.
- 1.3.4 Enter the EAA grounds through Gate 31. A map of the grounds is attached to this Bulletin. The EAA Security guard will check your credentials and let you through the gate. Parking is now in the L Lot. Everyone will park in the L Lot just outside of Gate 31 with the exception of KVG who will have special parking passes.
- 1.3.4 Museum hours are from 08.00 to 17.00 CDT. From 17.00 to 18.00, the EAA Security guard will have a list of pre-registrants and will be able to issue a wristband and parking pass for that two-hour period. After 19.00, access to the grounds will not be possible.







- 1.3.5 Those who arrive by car, have not pre-registered, and are EAA and IAC members will be able to obtain credentials at the Museum lobby until 17.00 or from 17.00 to 18.00 at Gate 31. Please bring your IAC membership card to obtain credentials. Preregistration is highly desirable to avoid problems obtaining credentials even if only attending as an Observer(s).
- 1.3.6 If you or your family are coming as Observers, be sure to contact Contest Director Gary DeBaun (<u>b747inst@aol.com</u>) or Executive Director Lorrie Penner (<u>execdir@iac.org</u>) to get on the list. The latest lists of pilots, volunteers, and observers can be found here:

- 3.1 A photo of the entire Nationals group of participants to include pilots, officials, judges, volunteers, and helpers will be taken at 10.00 CDT, Saturday, 23 September.
- 3.2 The group photo will now be taken at the <u>EAA Aviation Museum</u>. Check with the lobby for location. This is a change from previous schedules which showed the photo was to be taken at the EAA Brown Arch.
